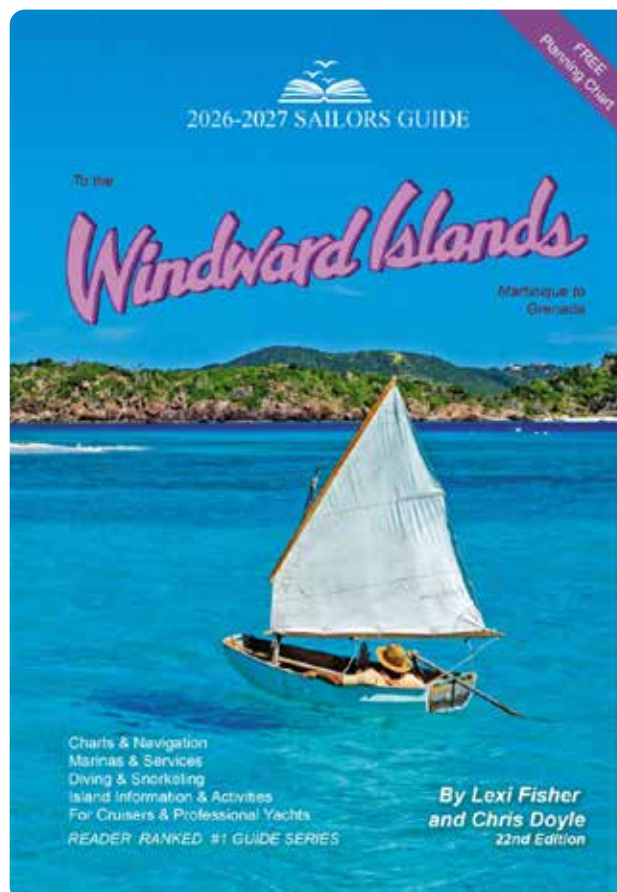




Chart 100 North Atlantic Ocean Passage Chart

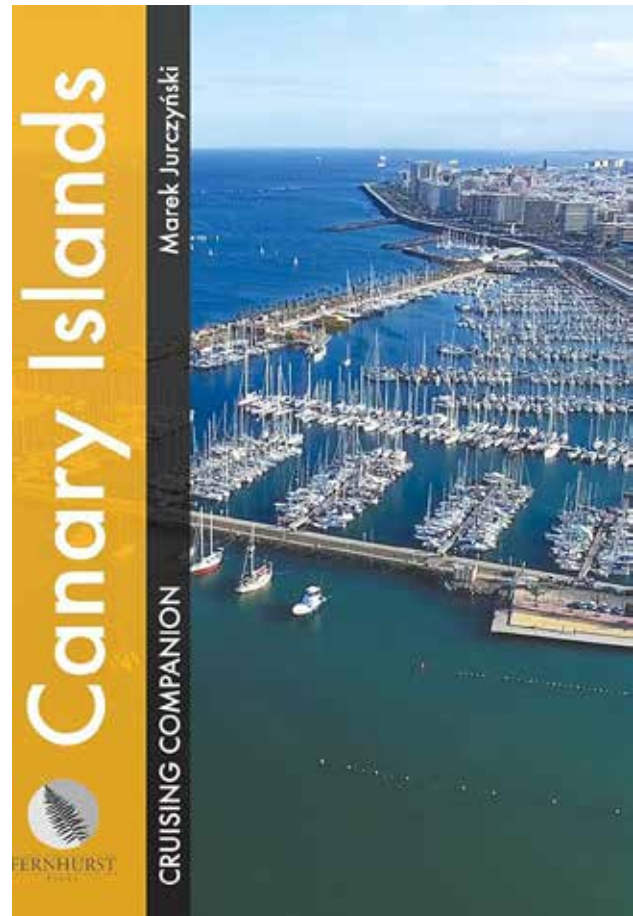

Approaching São Vicente

When approaching from the north-east, the western hills of São Vicente appear 'detached' from the main island. The Island of Santo Antão lies to the north-west, separated by a deep 6.5m channel (Canal de São Vicente), to the south-east is the Island of Santa Luzia. With its strong tidal stream, the Canal de São Vicente can build large seas, particularly on the flood. It is also known for its strong and gusty winds, where 10 knots elsewhere can increase to 25-30 knots between the Islands.

Please refer to the **Sailing Instructions for details** of the VHF Channels and reporting procedure as you approach.

Once across the line, take a direct course to the end of the grey stone breakwater.



Entry Formalities

Documents need to be presented to Rally Control as they will arrange clearances on behalf of the skipper. Documents required are as follows:

- Passports
- Police Form (provided by Rally Control)
- Original Ships Papers (returned at the end of your stay)

There is a Port Immigration fee of CVE500 or €5 per boat, independently of crew numbers and an additional surcharge applies at weekends. Any change to this will be notified during the Skippers' Briefing in Las Palmas. There is a \$25 for Australian passport- holders.

Arriving with Pets

Animals must be declared to the authorities on clearing into the country. A veterinarian health certificate/vaccination certificate should be presented. Dogs also require an additional rabies inoculation certificate. The animal may/may not be given permission to go ashore. Semi-feral dogs are common in the Islands so proceed with caution if given permission to take your dog/cat ashore.

Crew Changes in the Cape Verde

A visa is no longer needed for stays up to 30 days in Cape Verde. There is a visa exemption for 36 countries (European Union, United Kingdom, Andorra, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino, Switzerland and Vatican) in place.

Each person will require a valid passport to enter the archipelago by sea or by air. If arriving by plane, you also need to pay a fee:

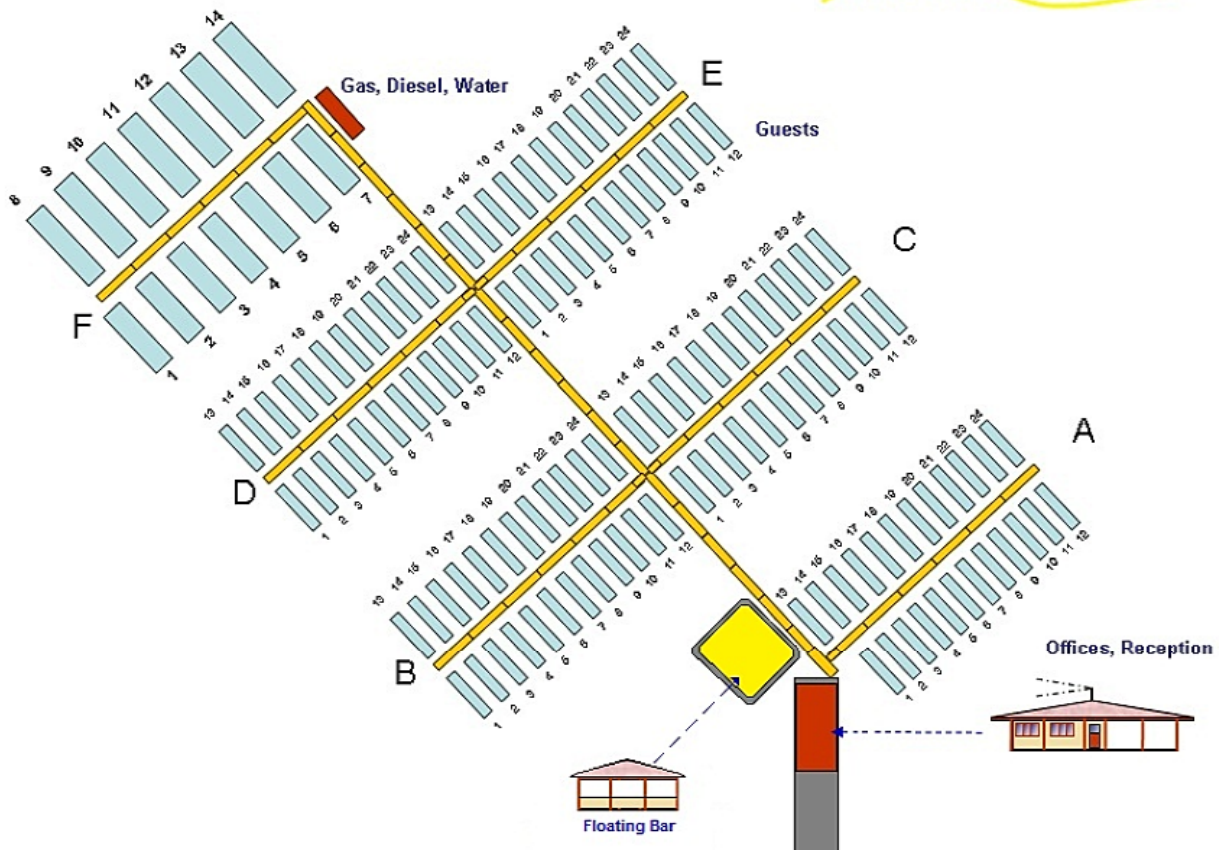
For domestic flights, the fee of CVE150 (about €1.40) will be charged at the time of airfare. On international flights, the TSA (Airport Security Tax) is worth CVE3,400 (about €31) and will be charged at the time of pre-registration on the online platform EASE. Pre-registration consists of completing passport and travel details. It must be made no less than 5 days before the start date of the trip to Cape Verde.

Mindelo Marina

Marina Mindelo is a 144 berth marina with all necessary facilities including; 24hr security, fuel, LPG, basic but adequate toilets and showers, and a floating Sailor's Bar.

The marina has floating pontoons with fingers, for boats up to 50m LOA and 4.5m draught. Access available at all tides and times of day.

It provides greater shelter than the anchorage, however, should a West swell set in during your stay, be prepared with springs and rubber guards for mooring lines. In a swell harbour such as Marina Mindelo, line handling with good slack does all the work. Pontoons are anchored to the seabed without fingers; instead there are mooring buoys for trying to or slack lines from the dock.

Berthing

The marina has floating pontoons and is designed to withstand swell. However, it can become roly in some conditions and boats should ensure their lines are tied correctly.

- One large yacht dock able to hold yachts up to 50m, and 4.5m draft in some areas.
- Stern to floating pontoon, buoys to make fast bow lines to, or slime lines from the dock.
- Access available at all tides and times of day.

The Entry Fee for ARC+ includes four nights complimentary berthing in Mindelo for yachts up to 19.81m.

Showers & Toilets

The showers are located by the marina office. Use water carefully – You will need your magnetic card for shower. Report faults and cleaning issues with the showers / toilets directly to the Marina Office.

Electricity and Water

Yachts should be aware the town of Mindelo does occasionally lose power, which consequently affects the power on the docks. However, the marina does have a separate generator for these instances.

Electricity is charged on a daily basis as follows: 32 Amps - €10.88 per day / 63 Amps - €22.67 per day (April 2025).

The water on the pontoons in the marina is NOT potable.

Bottled water is available from all the shops. Water is a scarce commodity, produced using diesel engines and consequently it is limited and expensive (€0.02/ litre).

100lt of non-potable water is included in berthing fees, which is for water on the pontoons AND marina showers. You will be given a magnetic card on arrival to enable you to access the water.

If you need a top up or an extra card, please visit the marina office. The price is €0.02/Lt and there will be no credit for units not used. Extra card has a refundable deposit of €10. It is recommended to fill tanks in Las Palmas, and if possible keep this water for the crossing. Bottled water is readily available.

Fuel

The fuel dock, located at the end of F pontoon, is open daily 08:00–18:00. Fuel is duty free for fuelling direct to the boat, however jerry cans cannot be filled. Payment can be in cash at €1.04/lt or €1.07/lt by card (November 2025).

To fill jerry cans, visit Enacol or Shell garage, both a short walk from the marina.

Entry Formalities

On arrival, all yachts must clear into Grenada as soon as possible - crew must remain onboard until this is completed:

1. Visit Customs and Immigration Office Located at Port Louis Marina, take boat papers, clearance out from your previous port, all crew passports and SailClear.com ID reference. Yachtsmen are permitted to stay on the island for a period of 3 months.

Office opens Monday-Friday 08:00-12:00, 13:00-15:00 and at weekends and public holidays 09:00-14:00. Clearance outside of these hours by prior arrangement. Overtime fee on weekends/holidays/ outside of hours (EC\$60 per vessel).

The Port Authority will charge port dues when you check-in, the amount depends on the yacht LOA.

2. Visit Port Louis Marina Office to confirm your berth location, as well as see the skipper's passport. They will then connect your electricity and water.

3. Visit the ARC Office Bring your YB Tracker, completed signed Arrival Declaration and survey. The ARC Plus team will also give you more information about the programme in Grenada, and how to contact the Grenada Tourism Authority for making the most of your time on the island.

Visas

Most nationalities will not require a visa for Grenada. A list of visa exempt countries is available from Grenada Embassies: grenadaembassyusa.org

Crew arriving by air to join the boat in Grenada must have a letter from the skipper confirming they will be travelling aboard and details an exact date of departure. (See page 68 in the Preparations section).



Arriving with Pets

Entry is easy for pets provided that the Veterinary department have been given the necessary details **in advance** and a Pet Import Permit has been issued.

Contact the Veterinary Department at grenadalivestock@gmail.com with a copy of the Health Certificate from the last port of exit, and valid vaccination records.

On arrival, all documentations and vaccination records need to be available and up-to-date.

Approaches to Grenada

The approach to Port Louis Marina and St George's is straightforward in all weather. The buoyed marina fairway is poorly lit but easy to identify and navigate. From a westerly direction to north of Annas Shoal there is a well-marked channel north-east of harbour (minimum depth of 19.5 metres) that leads almost to the quay. About 800 metres before quay, the channel turns north and there are shoals either side. Please refer to the Sailing Instructions for details of the VHF Channels and reporting procedure as you approach. On approach to the marina, Rally Control staff will direct you to your allocated berth via VHF. Remember: Grenada uses the American system ('Red Right Returning') with red buoys marking the starboard side of the channel on your arrival. Please pay special attention to commercial traffic when entering Port Louis Marina, especially along the Carenage waterfront in St George's itself.

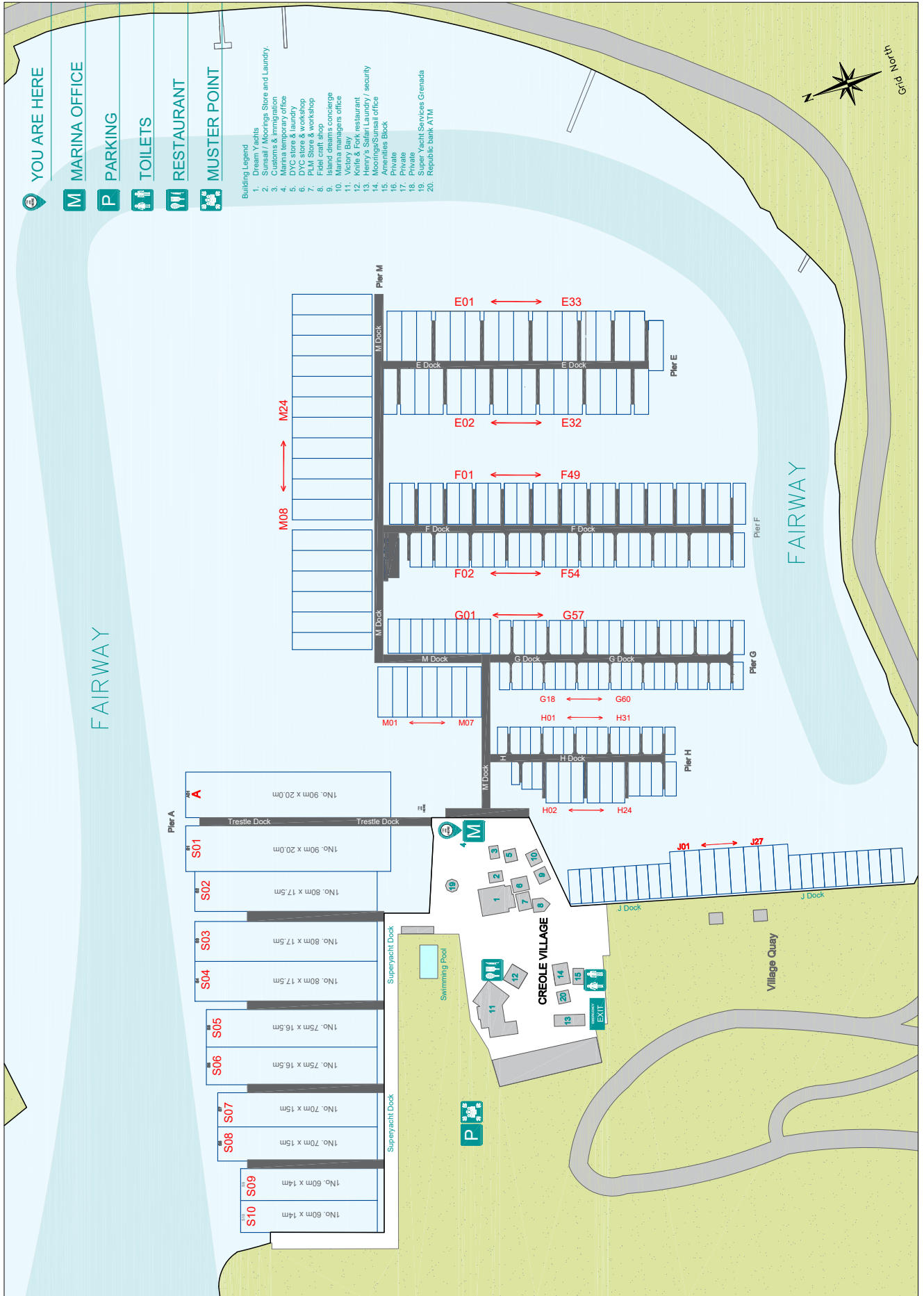
Towing

Facilities

Located in a lagoon just outside St. George's, the capital of Grenada, Port Louis Marina provides the perfect base to explore Grenada and the Grenadines.

The marina overlooks Carenage Waterfront and has 227 berths for yachts up to 300 feet.

The team at Port Louis Marina is headed up by General Manager Zara Tremlett. A Camper & Nicholson's Marina, Port Louis Marina boasts all the facilities you would expect, from clean and well-maintained washrooms, to fresh water and electricity at all berths. There is complimentary WiFi, bars, restaurants and shops at the marina and nearby, and a host of repair and maintenance services are available at Port Louis Marina. You will also find agents in the marina to assist with any yacht service requirements, including provisioning and transport.

Docking

Camper & Nicholson's Port Louis Marina provide ARC+ participants with 2 days complimentary berthing on arrival. ARC+ yachts also benefit from a 10% discount on dockage to any subsequent stays up to 31 May 2027.

The marina advises that you book in advance if you plan on staying after the New Year. Remember to make it clear that you are an ARC+ yacht when corresponding with the marina.

Long Term Docking Options

The Marina's location in the south-eastern Caribbean has a hurricane risk. Though considered south of the "hurricane belt", the possibility of named tropical storms and hurricanes does exist. Storms passing through the area, even a hundred miles away can affect the area with flooding and wind damage. Speak to the Marina Office for insurance options during the summer season and always check with your insurance company first.

Water and Electricity

Check the current prices of water and electricity with the Marina Office on arrival. Port Louis Marina offers both 110V /60Hz and 220V /50Hz. Potable water is available on all berths. As well as an internet box.

Please be advised that you will need a selection of power plug connections, for example to step down from 63 amp to 32 amp, to cover the range of outlets encountered both here and up and down the Caribbean.

Showers

Port Louis Marina shower / toilets facilities with a coded lock for the use of PLM customers/berth holders only. The showers are well maintained and spacious. Open 24/7.

There are also onsite bathroom facilities open to the public and guests. Open from 07:00-19:00.

Dressing Your Boat

All rally participants are asked to dress their boat with flags whilst in port to create a festive atmosphere! See Preparations section for details of how to dress your boat with code flags. Don't forget to fly your Rally flag too!

Finish Line Checklist

- As you cross the line, note your finish time for your Arrival Declaration.
- Call the Rally Control by VHF. See Sailing Instructions for the advised channel and calling process.
- Approaching the marina, find your marina plan - see page 49, and your Sailing Instructions.
- Upon entry to the Saint George's fairway call Rally Control by VHF. They will advise you on where you will be berthed.
- Prepare all fenders and mooring lines. Prepare lines for both port and starboard on the bow, stern and midships.
- After you have established contact with Rally Control and they have requested that you enter the marina, enter the marina slowly. The marina entrance is marked with a port and starboard light – remember, "red right returning".
- You will be greeted at your berth by the Yellow Shirts, whatever time of day or night you arrive.
- Once you are safely berthed, Yellow Shirts will give you information and explain how to check in.

Caribbean Travel Tips

- Grenadian people are known for being courteous and hospitable. Say "good morning," "good afternoon," or "good evening" when greeting people and on entering a store, restaurant etc.
- Make sure you try the local fruits and vegetables from the markets, stall holders will be happy to give you recipe ideas and cooking advice.
- Be patient, the Caribbean operates at a different pace.
- Be polite to boat vendors and other locals touting for business - a polite "no thank you, not today" with a smile, generally works well.
- Remember to ask for a receipt when you are asked to pay mooring fees anywhere in the Caribbean.
- Don't leave hatches open when you leave the boat - it can rain without notice!
- Be security conscious, lock your main hatches, dinghy and outboard at night and don't leave anything valuable on deck.
- Avoid walking anywhere to or from the marina in the dark - take a taxi. It is dark by 18:00.

Buses

Local buses can be used to get nearly anywhere at very little cost and generally operate between the hours of 0600 to 2100 from Monday to Saturday, less frequently on Sundays. Depending on your route, the fare can range from EC\$2.50 to EC\$6.50.

Bus services cover the whole island and can be hailed from anywhere. The buses are mini-bus sized, and painted a range of colours. Ask where they are going and how much the journey will be, as each bus is privately run.

Car Rental

Hiring a car is straightforward, reasonably priced and a good way to see the island. The marina office can arrange car hire or contact the companies directly.

Most rental car agencies require drivers to be 25 years and over. Before visitors get behind the wheel, they must first secure a Grenadian driving permit, which can usually be arranged by the rental agency. A fee of EC\$60 is required.
