1055 Preparatory signal


'P' flag hoisted & 1 short sound signal



1100 Starting signal


Both flags lowered & 1 long sound signal

Email / WhatsApp Rally Control with your time across the line and ETA at Port Louis


COMPLETE THE RALLY LEG DECLARATION WITHIN ONE HOUR OF FINISHING.


ONLY FIRST SUBMISSION WILL BE ACCEPTED


Arrival Procedure

- Yachts may be called by Coastguard on VHF 16 as you approach
- Yachts are only allowed to enter the port during daylight hours, from 0600 to 1800.
 - -If arriving at night suggest anchoring in quarantine area outside entrance channel found at approx. wp 20°8'36.00"S 57°28'16.20"E.
- At Outer Markers of Port Louis Channel
 - -Skipper must call PORT LOUIS HARBOUR RADIO on VHF Ch.12 or 14 requesting permission to enter the port.
 - -State distance and ETA to the Port and intention to dock at 'Caudan Basin'.
 - -Follow up by calling Rally Control on VHF 72, or message on WhatsApp if no reply.
- Entering the port
 - Once permission granted head to Le Port Customs Landing Steps
 - -Move to Caudan Basin once Customs & Immigration process complete

Mauritius Clearances

- Clearance may take place alongside Customs House or in the basin once moored.
- WCC will prepare the paperwork and will be available in Port Louis from 15th October.
- All skippers must complete Yacht Declaration which has been sent to you. Return to RC prior to departure from Cocos Keeling
- If clearance completed alongside Customs House proceed to the basin. RC will advise where you will dock and who you will be rafted to.




Berthing in Caudan Basin

- Courtesy flag, Red over Blue over Yellow over Green
- Minus 2.5 Hour Time Difference (UTC +4)
- Currency: Mauritian Rupees (MUR Rs)
- Conversation as of 01/10/2025:
 - -1 GBP = 61.36 MUR Rs or 100 MUR Rs = 1.63 GBP
 - -1 EUR = 53.60 MUR Rs or 100 MUR Rs = 1.87 Euro
 - -1 USD = 45.65 MUR Rs or 100 MUR Rs = 2.19 USD
 - -1 AUD = 30.12 MUR Rs or 100 MUR Rs = 3.32 AUD
